




## FUNDATIONS CHEAT SHEET

 a SCOOP stands for 1 syllable


 a C stands for CLOSED syllable


 a BREVE shows a SHORT vowel

 a BOX shows a WELDED sound

 one solid line shows a DIGRAPH

 separate lines show a BLEND


 a STAR shows a BONUS letter


 CIRCLE the SUFFIX (ex. ed, ing, es & s)

**V-E** a V-E stands for VOWEL CONSONANT E syllable


 A macron shows a LONG vowel


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**C** a C with a X shows  
a CLOSED syllable  
EXCEPTION  
(a ruler breaker)

**V-E** a V-E shows  
VOWEL CONSONANT E  
syllable EXCEPTION  
(a ruler breaker)

**O** an O shows  
an OPEN syllable

**r** an r shows a  
R-CONTROLLED  
(Bossy R) syllable

**O** Circle the vowel and consonant  
r because they do not make a long  
or short sound  
(OR AR IR ER UR)

**d** a d shows a  
DOUBLE VOWEL syllable  
(ex. ee ai oa ow oi ay)

**O** Circle the double vowel and say  
the vowels/keyword/sound

**-le** CONSONANT LE syllable  
the dash stands for the  
consonant

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
